The Transfiguration gave the three disciples a preview of Jesus’ future exaltation and the coming kingdom. The Lord was seen in His body of glory; Moses and Elijah illustrate those whom Christ will bring with Him (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18); the disciples represented those who will behold His coming (Revelation 1:7) <sup>1</sup>
